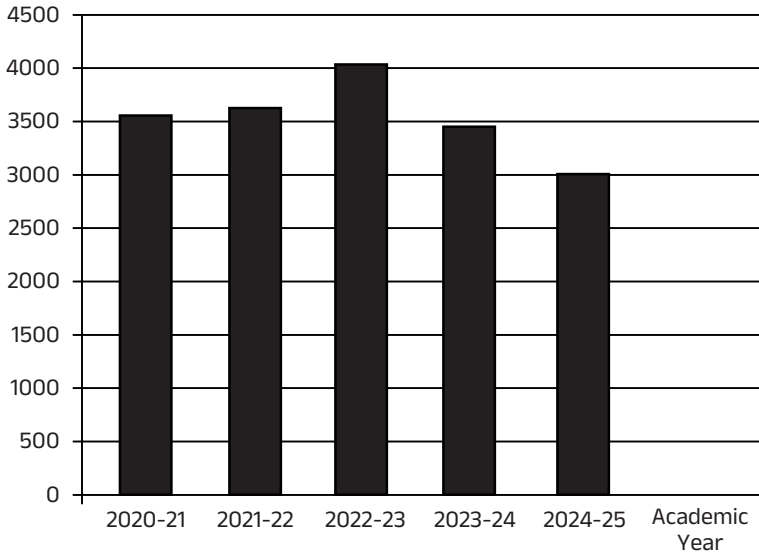

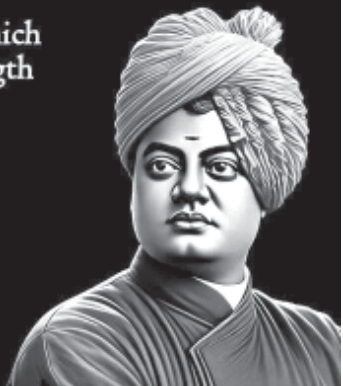

REGULATIONS FOR ADMISSION TO UNDERGRADUATE COURSES

Regulations for B.A. (Bachelor of Arts) Degree Course

1. ELIGIBILITY FOR ADMISSIONS

The following candidates shall be eligible for Admission to B.A. Degree Course.

- A candidate who has passed the Two Year Pre-University Examination of the Karnataka State or any other Examination recognized as equivalent there to.
- A candidate who has passed Two Year Job oriented Pre-University Diploma Examination conducted by the Director of Vocational Education, Government of Karnataka.
- A candidate who has passed the Two year Pre-University Examination from other State or any other Examination recognized as equivalent there to will be permitted to take Admission by fulfilling the Admission norm of this College.
- **Note : Online Application will be considered Prior Admission.**

2. COURSE OF STUDY

The course of study shall extend over a period of Three Years consisting of Six Semesters. Each Semester shall be of Six Months duration including Teaching, Fieldwork, Examinations, Evaluation and Vacation etc. The medium of Instruction shall be in English or in Kannada with exception in case of Language Papers. The Medium of Examination shall be in English or Kannada with exception in case of Language Papers.

Regulations for B. Sc. (Bachelor of Science) Degree Course

1. ELIGIBILITY FOR ADMISSIONS

The following candidates shall be eligible for Admission to B. Sc. Degree Course.

- A candidate who has passed the Two year Pre-University Examination of the Karnataka State or any other Examination recognized as equivalent there to considered as equivalent for Admission to B. Sc. Degree Course.

- A candidate who has passed the Two year Pre-University Examination from other State or any other Examination recognized as equivalent there to will be permitted to take Admission by fulfilling the Admission norm of this College.
- **Note : Online Application will be considered Prior Admission.**

2. COURSE OF STUDY

The course of study shall extend over a period of Three Years consisting of Six Semesters. Each Semester shall be of Six Months duration including Teaching - Learning, Fieldwork Excursions, Tour, Examinations, Evaluation and Vacation etc. The medium of Instruction shall be in English or in Kannada with exception in case of Language Papers. The Medium of Examination shall be in English with exception in case of Language Papers. The terms and vacations shall be as notified by the College from time to time.

Regulations for B.Com. (Bachelor of Commerce) Degree Course

1. ELIGIBILITY FOR ADMISSIONS

The following candidates shall be eligible for Admission to B.Com. Degree Course.

- A candidate who has passed the Two year Pre-University Examination of the Karnataka State or any other Examination recognized as equivalent there to considered as equivalent for Admission to B. Com. Degree Course.
- A candidate who has passed Two Year Job oriented Pre-University Diploma Examination conducted by the Director of Vocational Education, Government of Karnataka eligible for Admission to the B. Com. (I Semester) Degree Course.
- A candidate who has passed the Diploma course in Commercial Practice / Secretarial Practice Examination conducted by the Board of Technical Education, Government of Karnataka is eligible for Admission to B. Com (III Semester) Degree Course subject to the condition that he / she should pass the subject(s) prescribed for the I, II, III and IV Semester of the B. Com Degree Course which he / she not studied at the said Diploma Course.

- A candidate who has passed the Diplomas course in Business Administration Examination conducted by the Board of Technical Education, Government of Karnataka shall be eligible for Admission to the B.Com. (V Semester) Degree course subject to the condition that he / she shall pass the subject(s) prescribed for the I, II, III & IV Semester of the B. Com. Degree course which he / she has not studied in the said Diploma course.

2. COURSE OF STUDY

- The course of study shall extend over a period of Three Years consisting of Six Semesters.
- Every Student, after completion of study of Six Semesters but before appearing for Examination of VI Semester, shall submit a project Report in partial fulfillment of B.Com. Degree Course.
- The languages are permitted to be studied from I to IV Semesters. The student has to select any Two Languages from I to IV Semesters.

ATTENDANCE, PROGRESS AND CONDUCT

1. Each Semester will be taken as a unit for the purpose of calculating attendance.
2. The students must attend such course work during each Semester as prescribed by this Institution and will not absent themselves from work without adequate reason.
3. A student shall be considered to have completed a Semester if he / she has attendance not less than 75% of attendance during the said Semester and also if his / her Progress and Conduct has been found Satisfactory.
4. The Principal shall however have the power to condone the shortage of attendance up to 15% of the total number of working period in exceptional circumstances on the recommendations of the Head of the Department on payment of Penal Fee prescribed by the College from time to time
5. Students who fail to complete the course in the manner stated above shall not be permitted to appear for the Semester Examination.

SCHEME OF EXAMINATION

INTERNAL ASSESSMENT

1. There shall be three Internal Assessments in each of the Theory Papers consisting of 10 marks each. The concerned Teacher shall award the Internal Assessment (IA) marks, based on the best two Tests. The student who secure 80% and above attendance in Theory classes get two bonus marks in those Papers.
2. The Internal Assessment marks awarded shall be carried forward to the subsequent examinations when he / she reappears for the same Theory / Practical / Field Work / Tour.

EXTERNAL ASSESSMENT

1. The College shall conduct the Examination for all odd / even Semesters at the end of each Semester for 80 marks for each subject.

GENERAL RULES

1. Admission to all the classes is subject to the availability of Seats. Principal's discretion is Final.
2. Any Employee is not eligible for admission. Unless he / she should bring Permission / No Objection Certificate from the concerned Government / Semi Government / Aided Institution to fulfill the Attendance, Progress and Conduct of this College.
3. Department of Physical Education, NSS, NCC, Bharat Scouts & Guides, Red Cross units are open to all students.
4. Receipts of the fees paid must be kept safely till the course is completed
5. Discipline must be maintained in the College Campus.
6. Fee structure and Calendar of events will be notified on the college Notice Board.
7. Sufficient copies of all documents should be kept by the student with them before submitting the originals in office.

8. Percentage in the qualifying Examination is the criteria for selection to the I semester Degree Course. Reservation of seats is as per Government Rules. Vacancies in Reservation Quota will be treated as general pool seats. For a particular combination to be permitted there should be a minimum of 15 students in each subject, failing which the students will have to select the combination allowed by the Admission Committee.
9. Eligibility forms should be collected from the College Office at the time of I Semester provisional Admission and filled forms should be returned (online as well) to the Office within the stipulated date and time. Failure to submit will lead to cancellation of Admission by the College.
10. Admission purely on merit basis.
11. Roster system will followed

MANDATORY RULES

1. Uniform is Compulsory. No entry into the college campus without Uniform.
2. Student with less than 75% of Attendance shall not be considered for any Scholarship / Fellowship / Benefits provided by Government / Agency.
3. Mobiles Phones are not allowed inside the Class Rooms during Internal, Theory and Practical Examination.
4. Carrying ID Cards to College is Compulsory.
